

These issues include tall grass and are located covering 90% of your property. The items mentioned violate Municipal Code Section(s) 500.670, or 500.730, or 500.740.

We hope that you see the importance in maintaining your property and take the necessary action. If action is not taken by **August 25, 2014**, it will force us into a position where the city will take legal action which will result in fines and court action.
