

5. That petitioner, in her capacity as guardian and conservator, has expended time and effort in performing the ordinary duties and services necessary to fully administer the estate, including but not limited to general conservator's services and bookkeeping duties, filing of pleadings, court appearance, sale of real property in Scott County, Missouri, sale of real property in Wayne County, Missouri, trip to Greenville, MO for closing of sale of real property in Wayne County, Missouri, numerous trips to Sikeston, MO to show real property, clean-up of real property, changing of lock and going through home. Petitioner states that a reasonable and adequate compensation for such services, pursuant to the schedule of fees set forth in Section 473.153 RSMo. is \$934.26, which is set out as follows:

Proceeds from sale of real property - \$22,106.45

$\$5,000.00 \times 5\% = \250.00

$\$17,106.45 \times 4\% = \684.26

6. That if the court costs and the expenses of administration as set forth above are approved and paid in full, less \$350.00 for personal spending for protectee, there will be the sum of \$17,241.72 remaining for the payment of creditors of the estate. That attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as Exhibit B is a list of the creditors known to the guardian and conservator together with their classification as to priority as specified by Section 475.211 RSMo. and the proposed amount to be paid pro rata on claims .

WHEREFORE, petitioner prays the following orders of the Court:
